- ADA accessible rubberized play surface at playground
- Walking path connecting playground and exercise area
- Amenities to include drinking fountain, trash cans, mutt-mitt station
- Design approved by Facilities Committee and Library Board in Nov/Dec 2020
- Playground equipment and construction procurement in process
- Expected completion Fall 2021
